

Saginaw Township Soccer Association Scholarship Application

Income Limitations:

Potential recipients must submit a copy of Page 1 & 2 of Federal Tax Return to qualify. Each child living in the household may receive a scholarship to play soccer at the **Saginaw Township Soccer Complex at 3575 McCarty Road, Saginaw, MI 48603.**

Any Saginaw County resident is eligible as long as their Taxable income is below the following thresholds:

1	\$14,850	File application and copy of tax return pages to: Saginaw Township Soccer Association, P.O. Box 6155, Saginaw, MI 48608. You may also file it in person with any STSA Board Member who will forward it on to the Committee for Determination of Scholarship. The scholarship allowed for Recreation Players will include the entire player fee currently in force which is based on the age of the player: \$60 each for 7 and under and \$75 each for 8 and older children. Scholarship MAY also include the required jersey (\$15), Shin guards (\$5), Socks (\$5), Shorts (\$10). These additional items are only available if income is at the lower limits listed on the left. Maximum award is \$110 value.

Scholarships for Travel Players will be capped at \$200 which will be taken off the END of the monthly payments set up through the GotSoccer system. Each scholarship player shall pay for the uniform kit directly on their own through the web site as instructed. The remainder of the fee will be paid by the player at \$100 per month until balance is paid, after subtracting the scholarship amount.
